SECRETARY'S NOTES

Another Newsletter mailed and many have come back **POSTAGE DUE**. Some came back "Moved left no address Unable to forward", some with corrected addresses requiring re-mailing and some "Temporarily Away". We pay only \$.17 apiece to mail the News by "Bulk Mail Non Profit". For each returned Newsletter we pay \$.61 Postage Due and if the News is re-mailed we pay another \$.61 each. So to get the news to a member whose address is wrong on our list, it costs \$1.39 a piece instead of \$.17. Plus, we must insert it in an envelope for re-mailing.

It is very important to let us know about address changes. You see, if a change of address has been filed with the Post Office "First Class Mail" (with first class postage) is automatically forwarded to the new address without additional charge **but that does not apply to Bulk Non Profit Mail**. With reduced postage, Bulk non-profit mail that cannot be delivered as addressed is returned for (.61 postage due) with a corrected address label so that we can update our mailing list and re-mail the News. That is why it is so important that address changes be sent **to me**. **A CHANGE OF ADDRESS form is now on the last page of every Newsletter**. Or, if you prefer, just send an email to RAVAsec@aol.com, either way, I'll get it. **Remember**, that is an email address, **NOT A WEB SITE**.

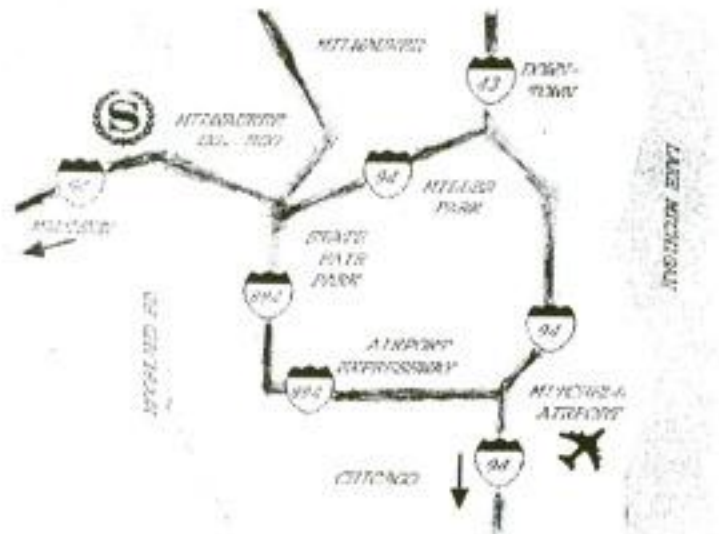

I was just 16 years old on December 7, 1941, when my older brother volunteered (Air Force) on January 1942 and a short time later he was in Australia and then on to New Guinea later to Clark Field in Manila, Philippines.

As time went by I became draft age. I had 12 weeks of basic training in Texas - Come December 1944 I was on my way to Leyte in the Philippines (The boat was the General A.E. Anderson) by it self with 6000 replacement troops. At about this time I found my-self with Co B 127 Inf Regt on the Villa Verdi Trail after being sent up as asst. B.A.R. man.

The days came and went - 3 weeks after the A Bomb was dropped we were in Fukkuoka Japan. We held classes in the concentration camps till they could be returned home.

Then in December 1945 the 32nd was deactivated and the group I was with was formed into the 519 M.P. Bn. From there I came home in the fall of 1946..

After getting home and reading of the Wisconsin National Guard 32nd Inf Div, 1st in combat, I am happy to say I was with them in the later part of WW !!.

I am 84 plus. I have been with you for some 10 plus years and may still make it to the reunion as I lost my wife of 59 years I have time on my hands.

Yes I am proud to have the Red Arrow on my cap. Have a good day.
